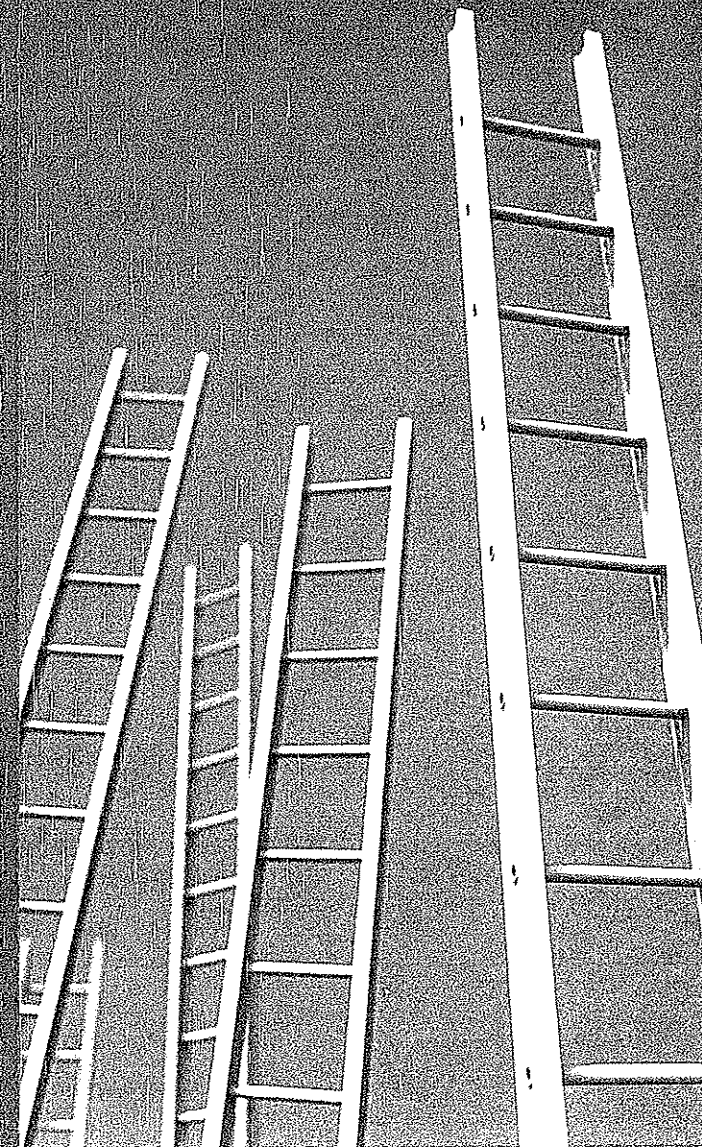

The programs we offer include:
